X-0 - Went to Humpack to reconnoiter for new C.P. and billets. Immediately after Bn Hq. arrived at Humpack X-0 & S-3 went to Div. Hq. to see Bn. C.O. Evidently troubles had arisen in the S-2 organization because when the X-0 arrived an entire new method of operation was explained to the asst. S-2. The new method was to operate as follows:

First, the S-2 would come back to Bn. Hq. rather than operating with the Div. Engr. Section. Secondly, the Reconnaissance section will operate back with Bn. Hq. under the S-2. The old method was to have one Recon. section act as liaison officer with the Line Companies. If the line Companies needed anything they would send the Recon section back to the Bn. Hq. who in turn would send him to the Div. Engr. This actually relegated the Recon section to being a high price messenger section. As a result no Engr. Recon. was taking place.

Third - Lt. Dennis was taken away from his Recon. section and made Special Service and Information & Education Officer.

Fourth - Sgt. Kubary was taken off the mail truck and will henceforth do Drafting for S-2 Section at Bn. Hq. We will record all information obtained from Recon. sections and anybody else who has information concerning Engr. operation.
