# ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD.

a. General Summary - Our advance restrained by blown bridges and moderate ey resistance, mostly SA.

#### b. Operations of Component Elements -

- (1) AT AT fire received from 245840 at 1600B.
- (2) Armor At 1645B, 3 ey tks moved S from 253800. At 1655B, AOP reported concentration of tks and vehicles at 283783. 1800B, 3 ey tks moved S from HOHENPOLDING (2585).
- Engineers Bridges out at 140892, 141901, 309845, 340844, 360865 (2), 339842, RUPRECHTSBERG (3685) (3), VILSBIBURG (4194).
- (4) Infantry Lt inf contact at 145907 at opening of period, at 152915 at 0600B, and at 173910 at 0700B. 75 ey reported 177910 at 0840B. Scattered SA was encountered throughout advance. At 1600B, SA recd from 245840. At 1900, a fire fight occurred vic REIN-TING (2584). Lt resistance was overcome in clearing OB H.SELBACH (3194) and VILSBIBURG (4194).
