b. Equipment Destroyed and Captured - Total planes on field 501735 that look to be in operational condition or could be made so with little work: 3 ME 109s, 15 small fighters, 3 1-engine trainers, 1 2-engine transport. Total guns and ammo destroyed: 11 multiple 20mm, 14 multiple 30 cal, 15,000 Rds 20mm, 5,000 rds 50 cal HE ammo.

c. Weather - 5 May 1945 - Low clouds, scattered to broken, some clear intervals late night and morning, occasionally over-cast with rain showers in afternoon. Surface wind North 6 - 12 miles per hour, temperature minimum 35 degrees F, maximum 40 degrees F.

6 May 1945 - Generally clear. Visibility good all period. Surface wind east 4 - 10 MPH. Temperature, minimum 36 degrees F, maximum 50 degrees F.

d. Censorship - Mention that Div is part of Third Army now permitted. No mention may be made of III Corps.
